Materials

Playing in the Rain Stamp Set

Playing in the Rain Dies

Cardstock - Fresh Freesia, Basic White, Pool Party

DSP – Delightful Floral (available online)

Ink Pads: Momento Black, Fresh Freesia, Lost Lagoon

Stampin Blends: Smoky Slate Light, Lemon Lolly Dark, Bubble Bath Light,

Crumb Cake Light, Calypso Coral Light

Other: Rain Drop Embossing Folder, Dimensionals All Purpose Glue, Stampin Seal, Wink of

Stella

Dimensions

Fresh Freesia Main Card Piece: 10 ½" x 4 ¼", 3 ¼ x 3 ¼"

Pool Party: 4" x 2 1/4" (2 pieces for Panel that gets Embossed)

DSP: 4" x 2" (2 for card front), 4" x 2" (2 for inside of card) 5/8" x 4" (for inside strip), 3" x 3"

Basic White Scraps for Bunny and Clouds, 2 1/4" x 4" (back sentiment piece)

Details:

Card Base: Scor Card Base at 2 1/4", 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 5", 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " stay on long side and flip piece so you can scor on the opposite end at 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " and 2 1/2" Fold for Valley, Mountain, Valley. The Mountain is the center pop out piece of your card.

Emboss the 4" x 2 1/4" Pool Party Pieces with the Raindrop Embossing Folder.

Adhere two of the DSP panels to the outside of the card. Adhere the other two DSP panels to the inside of the card. Now adhere your embossed pieces to the inside of the card. Adhere the 5/8" x 4" strip to the center part of your card.

With Momento Ink, stamp Bunny & Clouds on Basic White scraps, color with Stampin Blends and die cut.

Using Lost Lagoon ink, stamp raindrops onto the 3 x 3 piece of DSP (there are a couple of pages In the DSP with faded colors that look like sky). Adhere this onto the 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " piece of Fresh Freesia. Using dimensionals attach the Bunny and Clouds.

Place a few dimensionals down the center strip and adhere your bunny square.

Stamp the sentiment on the 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 4" Basic White and attach it to a back panel of the card base. So cute!!!
