Gone Fishing Dies
Layering Leaves Stamp Set – Inside Card
Sentiment
Celebrate with Tags Stamp Set – Happy
Birthday Sentiment
Cardstock - Boho Blue, Basic White, Real Red
DSP – Gone Fishing
Inks: Momento Black, Night of Navy, Mossy
Meadow, Real Red, Lost Lagoon. Flirty
Flamingo Light Blender Pen
Other: Dimensionals & Foam Adhesive Strips
Corner Round Punch, All purpose Blue and
Stampin Seal

Dimensions

Boho Blue 8.5" x 5.5", 5 1/8" x 4 1/8" DSP 5" x 3 5/8" Basic White 5" x 3 3/4", Scraps for tackle box pieces, Scraps of Real Red for tackle box pieces

Details:

Card Base: Fold the Boho Blue 8.5" x 5.5" in half (now 4 1/4" x 5"). Place the large open die so it sits just above the fold line. You do NOT want the die to cut below the fold line.

Die cut the 5 1/8" X 4 1/8" Boho Blue piece with the tackle box die cut. Be sure to hold out the die cut piece that you will later stamp Happy Birthday on.

Use paper snips on the DSP and round off the corners just a little bit.

Adhere the DSP to the card front. Use foam adhesive strips on the back side the tackle box around the outside edges and one strip in the middle to give support. Carefully align over your DSP and press down.

Stamp and die cut all your tackle box pieces. The Fish I stamped with Mossy Meadow and colored with the Light Flirty Flamingo Stampin Blend.

Using Dimensionals place your pieces in the Tackbox.

Stamp Happy Birthday in Night of Navy Ink on the die cut piece you set aside. Using All Purpose Glue adhere this on the front of your card (fits like a puzzle piece). It's best to use glue so you can slide it into position and adjust if necessary.



For the inside part of your card use the corner rounder on the Basic White 5 1/8" x 4 1/8" piece Using Night of Navy Ink stamp sentiment.
